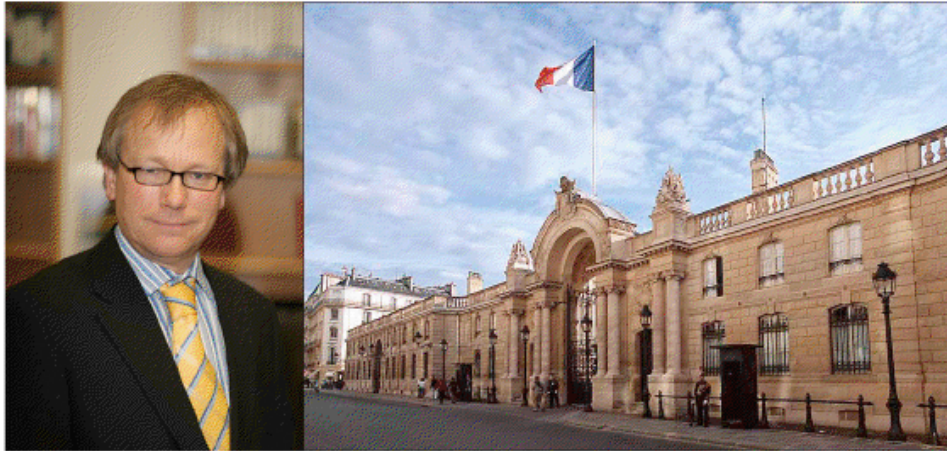

Professor Cole's research interests are in the sphere of contemporary and comparative European politics and policy, with special reference to France and Franco-British comparisons. He has led a series of comparative research projects on territorial and multi-level governance, public administration and the State, public policy, European integration and capacity building. His recent publications include: *Governing and Governance in France* (Cambridge: Cambridge University Press, 2008) and *Developments in French Politics 4* (co-edited with Patrick Le Galès and Jonah Levy, Palgrave, 2008) as well as numerous papers in leading political science and area studies journals.
